HENDERSON DRESS CODE 2022-2023

Land's End is the school's primary clothing vendor. While we prefer that families utilize this service, we recognize the importance of allowing families to have choices in clothing purchases. Families may utilize school-authorized local vendors to place the school's trademarked logo on clothing that complies with the dress code. Families are welcome to contact the school for a list of approved vendors. All students/families make choices within a range of options (styles, colors and fabrics) (no patterns).

Epiphany maintains The Falcon's Nest in Founder's Hall on Henderson which is a collection of gently used clothing at a tremendously reduced price. You might want to make The Falcon's Nest your first stop for your child's clothing needs.

As a general policy, we request modesty and require that all clothing worn to school must be in good condition (no holes, rips or frays) and should fit appropriately.

TOPS: Both Girls and Boys

- Any collared shirt in a solid color that is embroidered with the school logo (may be worn untucked).
- Any undershirt that is worn with Epiphany attire must be a solid color (no printed words/designs on sleeves).

BOTTOMS: Boys

- Athletic shorts and sweats are not allowed.
- Must be a solid color (no prints).
- Pants or shorts must be in cotton/cotton blend twill or corduroy fabric.

BOTTOMS: Girls

- Athletic shorts and sweats are not allowed.
- Pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, and capris must be in cotton/cotton blend twill or corduroy fabric, and must be a solid color.
- Leggings and tights are allowed under tops that completely cover the student's backside. Leggings must be opaque.

DRESSES

Must be either:

- Collared polo-style (similar to those offered by Land's End)
- A Jumper must have a collared shirt underneath.
- Jumper must be embroidered with the school logo.
- Leggings and tights are allowed under dresses of appropriate length.

SHOES

- Comfortable, flat, fully enclosed shoes should be worn at all times (examples: topsiders, loafers, sneakers, and boots).
- Shoes must be in clean, good condition.
- Shoes should be of adequate use for both physical education and community time.

• Shoes with blinking lights and/or wheels are not permitted.

OUTERWEAR

- Outerwear worn outside does NOT require an Epiphany logo. Small apparel logos are allowed. Outerwear may not include words, slogans or images.
- Sweatshirts, sweaters, and fleece vests in an array of colors are permitted in the classroom and require an embroidered logo.
- Epiphany athletics sweatshirts, sweaters, and jackets are permitted.
- Hats and gloves must remain in lockers once the school day begins.

JEWELRY & ACCESSORIES

- Large hoop earrings, dangling earrings, and face piercings are not allowed.
- Simple necklaces should be tucked inside the shirt collar.
- Bows, headbands, and barrettes should be simple without elaborate decorations.
- Sunglasses must be stored when indoors.
- Scarves and sunglasses must remain in lockers once the school day begins.

HAIR STYLES

- Students must refrain from having hair colors that do not occur naturally.
- Hair accessories, i.e. clips with unnatural hair colors, feathers, etc. are not allowed.
- Hairstyles should never impede visibility of the face and/or extend over the eyes and should not be distracting in the classroom.

DRESS UP DAYS

Throughout the school year, there are days and events that call for Epiphany students to wear their "Sunday best." On these days, young men are expected to wear a dress shirt and tie with dress pants, while young women must wear dresses or skirts of acceptable lengths (at least mid-thigh) or dress slacks. If the dress is sleeveless, a cardigan must be worn, as sleeveless tops are not permitted at the Lower School.

FIELD TRIP ATTIRE

When students leave campus for any school-related trip (including off-campus service), they are to wear the following:

- Khaki colored bottoms.
- A black collared shirt that is embroidered with the school logo.
- On occasion, the field trip attire may differ to include school issued t-shirts. Field Trip attire may vary based on the field trip activity or destination.

EPIPHANY SPIRIT FRIDAYS

Each Friday is a Lower School "spirit wear" day, unless otherwise specified by the Administration. On these days, students may wear tops that are not embroidered with the traditional Epiphany logo. All "spirit wear" tops must feature the Epiphany School's name, initials or official falcon mascot. Students must wear bottoms that adhere to the regular Lower School dress code guidelines.
